Your Parish Council met at Whitegate Primary School Hall for our ordinary parish council on Monday 11th September 2023. Three members of the Parish Council were in attendance.

Planning—the following applications were discussed:

23/02778/TPO Casia Green, Cassia Ln 1x Quercus Robur (Oak) Tree (entrance to field boundary) works required: crown lifting of lower branches to facilitate construction vehicles in association with improvement works to Marton North Wastewater Treatment Works(WwTW) - The Parish Council has no objection, however as we do not have the expertise we recommend the Tree Officer is consulted.
