

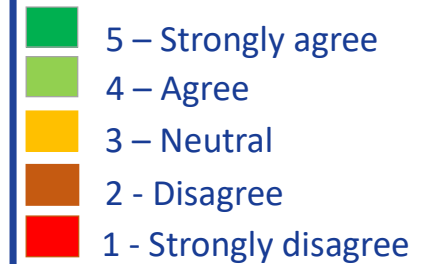
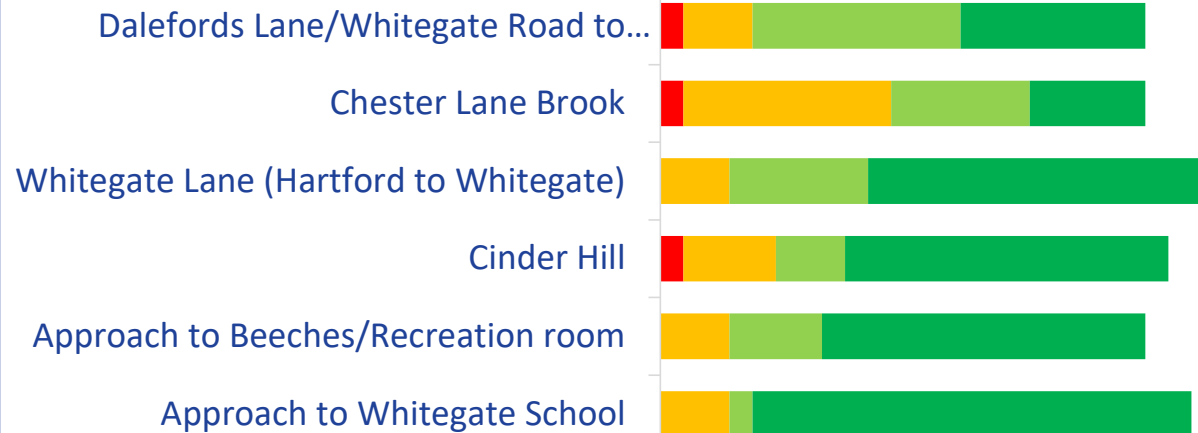
The results below show the responses of the Road Safety Survey of Whitegate and Marton residents when asked are these high priority areas still our top for road safety issues?



Road Safety Issues

OTHER AREAS TO CONSIDER

- *More sections of Dalefords Lane
- *Clay Lane
- *Mill Lane
- *Sutton Field



Other issues raised: School parking & safe accessibly to school
 Residents getting abuse and threats when turning into their drives
 Night time speeding
 Suggestions of solar powdered speed signs
 Crashes, fatalities, pets killed and feeling unsafe due to speeding
 The position of police speed vans when monitoring speed

INITIAL ACTIONS FROM SURVEY RESULTS *CINDER HILL, OPPOSITE OLD POST OFFICE IDENTIFIED AS SITE FOR DIGITAL SPEED SIGN *PCSO MONITORING DOWN CASSIA LANE * ROAD SIGNAGE TO DENOTE VEHICLES EMERGING FROM HOUSES ON WHITEGATE ROAD/CASSIA GREEN JUNCTION * REFRESH THE PAINTED ROAD MARKINGS FOR SAFE WAITING ZONE NEAR THE SCHOOL



OTHER ISSUES RAISED

- *Traffic calming and yellow lines to alert drivers to slow down around Whitegate school
- *Hedges & walls causing blind spots around the Parish
- *Road, verge, tree roots and kerb being damaged by vehicles parking for school pick ups/drop offs
- *Crossing the road opposite Church Lych Gate is very dangerous due to fast traffic
- *More warning signs on narrow roads
- *Speed reductions needed across the Parish
- *Larger vehicles not adhering to road restrictions
- * road surfaces in need of repair across the parish
