Your Parish Council met at Whitegate Primary School Hall for our ordinary parish council on Monday 8th January 2024. All members of the Parish Council were in attendance. No members of the public attended.

Planning—the following applications were discussed: None

There was no planning application for consideration. We took the opportunity to review the planning register recent update of granted and declined applications and reviewed our current list of enforcement matters.

Road Safety – Thank you to everyone who took time to complete our road safety survey, we had 24 responses. We are currently collating the results and will share a summary with you once it is completed. This will help us to update our current road safety priorities and determine how we can use our precept to improve road safety.

As previously reported the 6th June marks the 80th anniversary of D-Day, when allied forces mounted the largest amphibious invasion the world has ever witnessed. In 1944 Operation Overlord saw around 4000 ships and landing crafts set down about 132500 troops on five Normandy beaches in an action that would bring about the liberation of north-west Europe from Nazi occupation. Town and Parish Councils are encouraged to join with their local communities to take part in the D-Day 80 event. We thought it would be nice to mark the occasion with a more permanent reminder such as a new bench within the village, please do let us have your suggestions.
